Sheldon Chalet in Denali National Park

Witnessing the magic of the Northern Lights is high on many a bucket list—and now there's a super-secluded, [super-luxe lodge in Denali National Park](#) where sightings are all but guaranteed during Aurora season (which spans September 15 to March 1). Getting to the family-owned, five-room [Sheldon Chalet](#)—which opened last February on five private acres and has no Wi-Fi or cell service—requires a 45-minute helicopter flight from Talkeetna, a small town about two hours north of Anchorage. Once there, you can trek Ruth Glacier and build igloos and snow caves as well as dine on cuisine made with locally sourced ingredients such as Alaskan oysters, halibut, and king crab. (Even the water you drink is hyper-local, melted from glacier snow.) Come evening, settle in for the stargazing show of your dreams.
